Donaldson (Class 1)

The Donaldson Class have really enjoyed creating self-portraits and sharing toys from home that represent their interest and likes. We shared these in circle time and practised our 'good listening skills' to listen to each other and take turns talking. In PE, we have explored our gross motor skills with beanbag balancing, throwing and catching and with football with Ms Jones. We have practiced counting different objects, actions and sounds in Maths and have completed daily fine motor activities to support mark making and use of tools, such as tweezers, cutting with scissors, rolling playdough and tracing patterns. The children have loved making masks and dressing up as superheroes, creating narratives with their friends in their role play!

We've had a great week in Dahl Class! In Science, we went on a tree hunt around the school grounds and took photos with the iPads. We have had a very busy week in Seuss. We have been learning the Ukulele, we can't wait to impress you with our music. We have also been writing advertisements for Stonehenge and learning all about life at Skara Brae. In Science, we have been looking at food groups, such as Protein and Dairy. This has then been topped off by exploring Wifredo Lamm's masterpieces, and creating our own. Talking of masterpieces....
